- 1. PURPOSE. Proper documentation for Victim's Rights
- 2. POLICY. It is the policy of the Pineville Police Department that all members shall complete the Louisiana Victim Notice and Registration Form when appropriate.
- 3. LOUISIANA VICTIM NOTICE AND REGISTRATION FORM. It is the policy of the Pineville Police Department to advocate the rights of victims of crimes within the City of Pineville. Officers shall complete and forward the Victim's Right's form when the appropriate criteria is met. The following is a list of criteria:
  - A. The crime victim is a victim if the crime was committed or attempted against them within the guidelines of RS 14:2(13)
  - B. An arrest has been made or there is sufficient evidence at the time if the incident of the identity of the suspect.

- D. If the above criteria are met then the officer shall have the victim complete the form. The completed form shall then be forwarded to the officer's appropriate Bureau Commander.
- 4. In accordance with R.S. 46:1844(T)(2), "All victim notice and registration forms, and the information contained therein, shall be kept confidential by all law enforcement and judicial agencies having possession. The information shall be used only for the purposes required by this Chapter, and shall be released only upon court order after contradictory hearing."
