



<u>Distinguished Service-</u> Is presented to any officer that has rendered a service beyond the ordinary call of duty. It shall recognize these incidents where the officers diligence, perseverance, and timely judgment in the performance of a difficult task has resulted in the protection of life or property, the prevention of a major crime or the apprehension of an armed and dangerous criminal. The citation can be awarded with up to three devices.



<u>Life Saving-</u> Is granted to an employee for saving a human life. Saving a Life is the removal of a person from a place or situation where death would be imminent if the victim were not immediately removed, or the administration of CPR, Heimlich maneuver, stopping the free flow of blood, or the performing of a specific act which without death would be imminent. The citation can be awarded with up to three devices.

<u>Medal of Honor-</u> Shall be the highest recognition to be posthumously awarded to any member that has lost their life while in direct performance of their duty. This award is a tribute to the member's courage and dedication.
